Scheduled Lane Closures on Concord Blvd. to Begin Oct. 9

Concord, Calif. (Oct. 8, 2018) – After six months of recovery, demolition, assessment, and site preparation, we are poised to begin reconstruction and completion of the second phase of the Renaissance Apartments – the highly anticipated downtown multi-family housing development.

To facilitate the reconstruction, the developer has requested six dates over the next month during which they will require a full-day single lane closure on Concord Boulevard (between Galindo and Mira Vista Terrace) along the front of the project area, in order to assemble a tower crane and pour the concrete foundation to replace the foundation that was damaged in the fire.

City staff will monitor the traffic situation throughout each day that the lane closures are in place, working with the contractor to facilitate re-opening all lanes as early as possible. Currently, we expect the lanes to be closed from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. on each of the following days.

The scheduled dates for full lane closures are:

- Tuesday, October 23
- Thursday, November 8
- Friday, November 9
- Wednesday, November 14
