



Concord Postpones March 12 Council Meeting

Concord, Calif. (March 12, 2020) – In light of public health concerns related to coronavirus (COVID-19) and in compliance with State and County recommendations for social distancing, the City of Concord is postponing its March 12 Special City Council meeting. City staff are evaluating options that allow for essential City meetings to continue in a way that is consistent with public health guidelines.

The March 12 meeting agenda item entitled “the City’s response to Lennar’s letter of January 17, 2020 related to the Reuse Project at the former Concord Naval Weapons Station” has been postponed. The tentative new date is Tuesday, March 24.

The City has also taken additional precautions to ensure the health of its senior population. Effective March 13, the Concord Senior Center has cancelled all programs. However, the Senior Center will remain open to facilitate the senior nutrition program, which will be providing take-away meals in lieu of sit-down meals.

The City of Concord will continue to monitor and evaluate the public health situation and update its practices based on the State and County guidelines.
