



## **Music & Market Returns July 15 to Concord's Todos Santos Plaza**

**CONCORD, Calif. (July 2, 2021)** – The City of Concord has announced that its popular concert series, *Music & Market*, will return this summer to Todos Santos Plaza on Thursday, July 15. Last year's series was canceled due to the citywide effort to slow the spread of COVID-19.

*Music & Market* is a Concord tradition enjoyed by thousands of people each summer who come from all over the East Bay to experience live music by local bands and pick up farm-fresh produce at the farmers' market.
