



DEPARTMENTAL REGULATIONS

Chief of Police

GENERAL PROVISIONS

- PR-100 Police regulations are to take effect on the date indicated on the receipt and certification which will accompany them during their distribution.
- PR-101 Police regulations are applicable to all officers of the department and, where specified, to all employees of the department.
- PR-102 All existing rules, regulations, orders, and instructions in conflict with these police regulations are canceled.
- PR-103 All general and special orders, instructions (including those on departmental forms), and manuals not in conflict with police regulations shall have the same authority as police regulations.
- PR-104 Police regulations or General Orders shall not be canceled, amended, or issued without the approval of and over the signature of the Chief of Police, or in his absence the officer designated by the Chief of Police, or City Manager as Acting Chief of Police.
- PR-105 Failure of an employee, either willfully or through negligence or incompetence, to perform the duties of his rank or assignment, or violation by an employee of any police regulation or order or instruction having the effect of a regulation or order, may be considered sufficient cause for discharge, demotion, suspension, or other penalty.
