2. **LIAISON GROUP REPORTS AND PROJECTS**
 - A. **REPORTS** – *Vice Chair Hornstein attended the county Advisory Council meeting and the public meeting on AAA Plan Update for Fiscal Year 2014-2015. Hornstein shared the other events that are occurring in the county. Commissioner Pascual attended the Heritage Resident Meeting and was introduced to the group by Nancy Samson. There were several concerns from the residents; ongoing issue with raised sidewalk (brought up 2 years ago but has not been addressed) that is detrimental to blind people, people with walkers or wheelchairs, not sufficient parking and public parking is used by kids inappropriately, mugging, and no smoking ordinance not enforced. Commission Pascual shared the upcoming taxi script program.*
 - B. **TAXI SCRIP** – *Staff reported the city attorney is reviewing the program and application for participants. The request for information is completed and waiting to hear from the city attorney's office. Printing services will do a short run of 200 booklets.*
 - C. **BE A SANTA TO SENIOR** – *Commissioner Rogers will follow up with the Ombudsman's Office to see if we could get 15 new board and care homes for this year's program and will confirm with Spaghetti Factory to host a tree. Vice Chair Hornstein will check with the Police Department and staff will check with Min's Kitchen and city hall to host a tree for this year.*
