Interviews to fill four member positions on the Concord Pavilion Community Outreach Committee are scheduled to begin at 4:30 p.m. on Monday, March 23, 2015.

Background

The Concord Pavilion Community Outreach Committee (Committee) will consist of five members holding two-year terms; and comprised as follows: four members appointed by the Concord City Council (aka: City members) and one member appointed by the Manager of the Pavilion (Live Nation) (aka: Manager member).

The Committee shall provide guidance to the Pavilion General Manager on outreach efforts to attract applications from local schools, cultural organizations and the community to bring additional community events to the Pavilion which will expand the use of the venue beyond the concert season. The Committee will assist the Pavilion General Manager in identifying potential community events, but will not have authority to approve or disapprove of event applications. The Committee will be responsible for assigning a Committee member to take notes of Committee meetings and complete a record of annotated minutes.

The Committee shall determine the frequency of its meetings, which shall be not more than once per quarter and will not conflict with Pavilion events.

On February 3, 2015, the City Council announced the opening of a recruitment to fill four positions, and set the deadline for receipt of applications to Friday, March 6, 2015, at 5:00 p.m.
