
- 1. REVIEW** – Proposed FY 2014-15 City Council Services Program Budget. Report by Mary Rae Lehman, City Clerk

ACTION: City Clerk Mary Rae Lehman gave a report referring to the memorandum dated March 18, 2014 and advising that there were minor proposed increases in the City Council Supply account to cover the upcoming visit by a delegation from Kitakami and the City Council Meetings and Training budget to provide funding for attendance at the National League of Cities Conference (NLC). Mayor Grayson expressed his desire to include membership costs for the National League of Cities organization stating that during his recent attendance at the Spring NLC he was denied access to all conference sessions due to lack of membership. Mayor Grayson also suggested that attendance at the U.S. Conference of Mayors be added to the Meeting and Training Budget with a notation that attendance was not recommended this upcoming fiscal year.

Vice Mayor Leone concurred and stated that the fees for membership in the NLC and the U.S. Conference of Mayors should be included in the budget, with the notation that the memberships were not recommended for Fiscal Year 2014/15 due to budget constraints.

City Clerk Lehman offered to provide information on each of the two organizations to assist the Council in determining the value of membership to the City of Concord.
