a. Discuss Establishment of an Education Commission. **Report by Kathleen Salguero Trepá, Assistant City Manager.**

ACTION: Kathleen Trepá presented the staff report. Committee members discussed the goal of improving communication with the Mount Diablo Unified School District (MDUSD), advocating for the District, and sharing positive information with the community about public education opportunities and programs. Committee members agreed that as an initial step the Youth and Education Committee could work on obtaining a better understanding of local school performance, and requested staff contact MDUSD for additional information regarding recent school test score results and performance rankings, including any historic trending that may be of interest to the community. Staff will also forward MDUSD Board agendas with a brief summary of any

items of significant interest on a monthly basis. The Committee did not think it was necessary to establish an Education Commission at this time but would instead work on the goals noted above at the Committee level.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Ray Barber spoke in support of economic development being good for the City as well as MDUSD, and that to best understand school issues someone should attend MDUSD Board meetings.
