PRESENTATIONS

DISCUSSION OF COMMON CORE STANDARDS/UPDATE ON LOCAL CONTROL ACCOUNTABILITY PLAN (LCAP) – Dr. Nellie Meyer

Superintendent Dr. Nellie Meyer gave a presentation explaining Common Core Standard, presented an update on the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP), and answered questions about the District's operations, goals and objectives.

Local Reuse Authority Executive Director Michael Wright presented an update on the development of the Concord Naval Weapons Station and the selection process for a Master Developer.

Guy Moore, Mt. Diablo Education Association, spoke of a partnership between the City, Mt. Diablo Unified School District, and the Mt. Diablo Education Association focused on building new schools on the project site.

Willie Mims, East County NAACP, questioned if the Master Developer would be required to prepare an Environmental Impact Report (EIR).

Mayor Grayson closed the public comment period, and Lt. Menchaca answered follow-up questions.


OTHER MUTUAL AREAS OF INTEREST


Mayor Grayson opened a public comment period.
