Regarding Disclosure of Information to the Public

All applications for City Boards, Commissions, and persons representing the City of Concord on Advisory Committees, are subject to the Public Records Act. Every application becomes a public record and all information contained in the application is available for public scrutiny. Names, addresses and telephone numbers are often requested and made available to the public.

Members of selected boards and commissions are also subject to either State or City Conflict of Interest laws and are required to complete a Statement of Economic Interests at the time of appointment, annually, and at the end of their service. Interviews for positions on the City's Boards and Commissions are conducted by specified City Council Committees at a public meeting.
