**SUBJECT: ANNOUNCEMENT OF AN UNSCHEDULED VACANCY ON THE CITY OF CONCORD PLANNING COMMISSION AND DETERMINATION OF WHETHER TO APPOINT AT THIS TIME OR PUBLISH FORMAL RECRUITMENT****Report in Brief**

There is an unscheduled vacancy on the City of Concord Planning Commission due to the resignation of Planning Commissioner Robert Hoag. The City Council may fill the vacancy either by commencing a formal recruitment or by appointing from a pre-existing list of applicants. Regardless of the approach decided upon by Council for filling this position, the Council may elect to consider all existing applications for the position—whether from the existing list or that have been received since the Notice of Unscheduled Vacancy was posted on December 22, 2015.

Staff is recommending that the Council provide direction to staff on its desired approach for filling the currently vacant position.

**Background**

Planning Commissioner Robert Hoag resigned his seat effective December 17, 2015 leaving an unscheduled vacancy on the Planning Commission. Commissioner Hoag's term expires February 28, 2017.

**Discussion**

Government Code section 54974 (the Maddy Act) requires that whenever an unscheduled vacancy occurs, a special vacancy notice shall be posted by the City Clerk. This unscheduled vacancy was posted on December 22, 2015, as required by the Act, but other than that posting, no formal "recruitment" has commenced. The City does have an existing list of applicants from a recruitment held in August 2015, and the Council may appoint from that list and from any applications that have already come in as a result of the Notice of Unscheduled Vacancy that was posted on December 22, 2015.

Although Council can appoint at this time, it is also within Council's discretion to publish and post a formal recruitment. Council Policy No. 89 provides in Section 4.2 that where openings occur prior to the expiration of a member's term, the Chair of the Council Committee may make a recommendation to appoint from an existing applicant list, or recommend to the full Council that the Council call for a recruitment to obtain new applications to fill the unexpired term. In the case of a Planning Commission vacancy the Council as a whole (rather than a Council Committee) interviews applicants.

The application list for the Planning Commission used in November 2015 includes six names. Since the Maddy Act posting of the current unexpected vacancy one additional individual has submitted applications. All of these applications are attached to this staff report for Council consideration, should Council decide to appoint from this pool of candidates.

Serving on the Planning Commission is an opportunity for individuals to serve their community; Opening recruitment for the unscheduled vacancy may increase public interest and participation in the community. Should Council choose this approach, staff recommends that all individuals on the current list be automatically placed on the new list.

**Public Contact**

A Notice of Vacancy was posted at the Senior Citizen's Center, Concord Police Department, Concord Library buildings, and in the City's agenda display case on December 22, 2015.


If Council decides to do a full recruitment, a news release will be issued and all interested parties will be notified. Additionally, the announcement will be broadcast on the Concord TV Cable Channel 28 (Comcast) and Channel 29 (Astound) Community Bulletin Boards, and posted at the Senior Citizen's Center, Concord Police Department, and Concord Library, in the City's agenda display case, and the City's webpage.

**Recommendation for Action**

Staff recommends that Council direct staff on their desired approach to filling this unscheduled vacancy on the Planning Commission.

If Council desires to fill the position from the existing list, it may do so during the Council meeting. All applications have been attached. The Clerk will have ballots available to Council for voting at the public meeting.

If Council desires to open a recruitment and allow all interested individuals an opportunity to apply to fill this unscheduled vacancy on the Planning Commission, staff recommends Council set Friday, February 12, 2016, at 5 p.m. as the deadline for receipt of applications by the City Clerk.
