Subject: **Reappointment of Keith McMahon to continue to serve as the City of Concord's Representative on the Contra Costa County Aviation Advisory Committee for a three-year term ending March 1, 2019**

RECOMMENDATION

Approve the recommendation for reappointment of Keith McMahon to continue to serve as the City of Concord's representative on the Contra Costa County Aviation Advisory Committee (CCCAAC) for a three-year term ending March 1, 2019. The CCCAAC is a County committee; therefore, the County Board of Supervisors makes the formal appointment for the seat reserved for a Concord representative.

BACKGROUND AND JUSTIFICATION

The CCCAAC is charged with advising and recommending to the Board of Supervisors on the general subject of aviation issues related to airports in Contra Costa County. The membership of twelve is comprised of five members each named by one of the five Supervisors, one member each from Concord and Pleasant Hill, one member from Diablo Valley College, one member representing the Fixed Base Operators' Association, one member representing the Airport Land Use Commission, one member representing property owners and tenants in the vicinity of Buchanan Field Airport, and one member representing residents, businesses, and users of the Byron Airport.

On March 22, 2016, the Council approved the recommendation of Keith McMahon's continued service on the CCCAAC for a two-year term ending March 1, 2018. After mailing the recommendation to the CCCAAC, staff was informed that the CCCAAC's bylaws changed in 2014, and they appoint for three-year terms. Therefore, this item is

being returned to the Council to adjust the term to three years, for a term ending March 1, 2019.

Keith McMahon is the past president and CEO of the Greater Concord Chamber of Commerce and remains actively involved in the community. During his service with the Chamber of Commerce Mr. McMahon established relationships with business, residential, and special interest groups who have a specific interest in the future of the Buchanan Airport.
