Subject: **Interview applicants to fill an unexpected vacancy on the City of Concord Planning Commission for a term ending February 28, 2017**

Report in Brief

Interviews to fill an unexpected vacancy on the City of Concord Planning Commission are scheduled for Tuesday, July 5, 2016, as a result of the resignation of Planning Commissioner Ernesto Avila for the remainder of his four-year term ending February 28, 2017.

Recommended Action

Staff recommends that the City Council interview candidates for the Planning Commission vacancy on Tuesday, July 5, 2016, and appoint an applicant to the Planning Commission by ballot at the July 12, 2016, City Council meeting.

Background

On March 16, 2016, Planning Commissioner Ernesto Avila was appointed to the Contra Costa Water District Board of Directors, leaving an unscheduled vacancy on the Planning Commission.

The recruitment to fill the position was announced on April 5, 2016, and May 6, 2016, was set as the deadline for receipt of applications by the City Clerk.

Applications were received from Mark Weinmann, Ronald Glas, Devlyn Sewell, Kimberly McCarl, Colleen Geraghty, Pablo Benavente, Jesus Gomez, Elizabeth Copley,

Partha Parthasarathy, Jordan Damerel, Ernie Gonzalez, Dominic Aliano and Ajit Kaushal; totaling 13 applications.

Analysis

The City Council will interview candidates for the Planning Commission vacancy on Tuesday, July 5, 2016. The appointment of an applicant to the Planning Commission by ballot is tentatively scheduled for the City Council meeting of July 12, 2016.

A Notice of Vacancy was posted on March 18, 2016.

A press release announcing the openings was distributed to the media and posted at the Senior Citizen’s Center, Concord Police Department and at the Concord Library. The announcement was televised on Concord TV Cable Channel 28 (Comcast) and Channel 29 (Astound) Community Bulletin Boards.
