Lodging



Camp Concord has 28 cabins, 7 staff quarters, 2 bath houses, a centralized dining/meeting hall, and an office. Of the 28 cabins, 18 have electricity and are equipped to sleep 5 to 8 individuals on double, single, and bunk beds. The other 10 cabins are a bit more rustic and do not have electricity. These cabins are typically used to accommodate youth groups with the ability to sleep up to 12 individuals on bunk beds. All cabins have convenient access to restrooms, hot showers, laundry facilities and the main lodge. Limited wheelchair accessibility is available.
