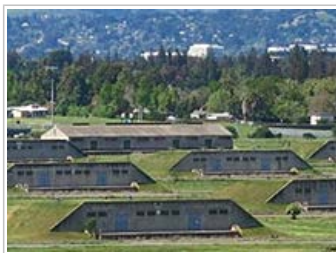
## Free Zumba demo in Todos Santos Plaza Saturday

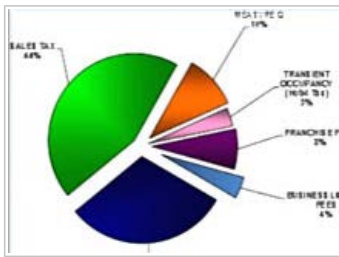
## Have some summer fun in the water

## Concord Fun Facts: Baseball's Tom Candiotti

Baseball great Tom Candiotti, born in 1957, is a former right-handed pitcher in Major League Baseball who was known for his knuckleball. He is a graduate of Concord's Queen of All Saints Catholic School, Concord High School, and an alumnus of Saint Mary's College in Moraga. During his career, he played for several teams including the Oakland A's and Los Angeles Dodgers. At the time of his retirement, Candiotti ranked in the top 100 all-time in major-league history in starts and strikeouts.
