Home repair help available

Low- and no-interest deferred loans are available to low-income homeowners in the City of Concord to assist with bringing properties up to health and safety codes, repair roofs, electrical or plumbing, and install handicap accessibility aids. Seniors can get help with winterizing their homes, security doors and lighting and other projects. The program is administered by Hello Housing, a nonprofit housing organization.
