




- **Three Prong approach**
  - Education
  - Intervention
  - Suppression

# SPECIAL ENFORCEMENT TEAM (SET)

## JANUARY 20 – JUNE 30 2016

- 323 arrests
- 133 Street Gang Intelligence reports created
- 33 guns seized from convicted felons, gang members, and other dangerous individuals
- Three-quarters of a pound of methamphetamine seized
- 12 and one-half pounds of marijuana seized
- Seizure of more than \$21,000 in cash suspected to be proceeds of drug sales
- No gang homicides
- Hundreds of CPD police stickers handed out to children

# **SPECIAL VICTIMS UNIT (JAN – JUN 2016)**

- **6 Detectives**
- **1183 total reports assigned**
- **462 of the 1183 reports were DV investigations**  
(remaining cases were: molestation, child pornography, human trafficking, abuse, neglect, assaults, RAJ's)
- **Tasked with registering 220 Sex Registrants in Concord**

## **DV Advocate Irene Van Der Laan:**

- **571 phone calls**
- **Attended victim and support group meetings**
- **257 Personal victim contacts**

# LETHALITY ASSESSMENT PROGRAM (LAP) (JAN - JUN 2016)

---

- Homicide Reduction Grant
- Any DV-related calls, where victim could be in danger, results in LAP screening at scene
- High Danger victims are immediately connected to STAND


## LAP Statistics

# CENTRAL FAMILY JUSTICE CENTER JAN-JUN 2016


- 535 clients and 537 children assisted at the FJC




# BURGLARIES JAN - JUN 2015/2016 (PIE)

January-June 2015



## Homeless Stats

- Homeless contacts: 587
- Homeless referrals: 23
- Citations: 39
- Arrests: 103
- Reports: 100
- Miscellaneous (Patrol Assists: NAT, GOA, UTL): 437
- Camps tagged: 46
- Camps cleaned: 18

## CIT Success Stories

- 1700 block of Denkinger Road – Known problem house, with homeless subjects frequenting for drug use, drug selling and trading, and fencing of stolen property. Son of owner, evicted, and assisted through detox program.
- Three chronic Concord alcoholic homeless subjects entered into long-term programs out of area, since March/April, still succeeding.
