## Scholarship Process

The Concord Senior Center Scholarship Program is available to adults age 50+ residing in Concord who wish to participate in the Parks & Recreation Senior Center programs. Approved applicants are eligible for a maximum of \$100 per individual per year.

Scholarships are available for the City of Concord Senior Center Classes, Day-Trips, Special Events, Concord Senior Citizens Club Activities. Exclusions: Casino Trips and Club Bingo.

1) Complete this Scholarship application and provide proper supporting documents for income qualification. All information will be kept confidential. Check off type of scholarship: Senior Center, Senior Center and Club or Special Recreation, and 5 Aquatic scholarships.

2) Mail or drop off application form indicating which class, activity, or trip and activity number and include the \$5 co-pay.

3) Scholarships will be reviewed and available 5 business days after approved. A receipt will be emailed or mailed to your home.

4) Note: Scholarships are subject to availability. Register early as spaces are limited. No credits for missed classes or withdrawals.

## Scholarship Qualifications

- Applicant must be a Concord Resident.
- Household must not exceed the following maximum income requirements based on household size:

Household Size	Maximum Income*
1	\$32,200
2	\$36,800
3	\$41,400
4	\$46,600

- Awards will be made as long as funds are available.
- Scholarship is good for **one year** calendar year. **Funds must be used by 12/31.**
- Continuing applicants must complete a new application to renew their scholarship each year.
