



PUBLIC HEARING

CITY OF CONCORD CANNABIS REGULATIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Concord will consider an introduction of an Ordinance amending Concord Municipal Code Chapter 5.80 (Cannabis) and Development Code (Title 18) to allow adult-use City Cannabis Licenses for manufacturers and distributors (Type 13); increase the maximum number of City Cannabis Licenses for manufacturers, distributors (Type 13), and testing laboratories; and to allow City Cannabis Licenses for retail (storefront and non-storefront, microbusinesses, and Type 11 distributors) by reading of the title only and waiving further reading. CEQA: Not a “project” under CEQA Guidelines Sections 15060(c), 15378 and Public Resources Code 21065; in the alternative, if deemed a “project,” exempt pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) and Business and Professions Code Section 26055(h).

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Concord will hold a **PUBLIC HEARING** by **teleconference/electronic** on this matter on **Tuesday, April 28, 2020**, at 6:30 p.m. (or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard) at which time and place interested persons may appear and be heard.

In response to COVID-19, the Contra Costa County Health Department and the Governor for the State of California have issued stay-at-home orders, which include directives to avoid mass gatherings and to maintain social distancing. The City has also declared a local state of emergency.
