



Concord Voters to Participate in City's First By-District Elections

Online mapping tool helps voters find their district

Concord, Calif. (Oct. 10, 2018) – This November, Concord voters will participate in the City's first by-district elections in which three of Concord's five districts will be up for election.

For the first time, candidates may only be elected by the people who live in their district. The seats up for election this year are:

District	Candidates
1	Judi Herman, Laura Hoffmeister, Ron Leone
3	Dominic Aliano, Kenji Yamada
5	Tim McGallian
Treasurer	Patti Barsotti

Voters will elect candidates for Districts 2 and 4 in the November 2020 election. Voters in all five districts will continue to elect the City's at-large Treasurer.

To help voters identify their district, the City has developed an online mapping tool in which residents can simply enter their home address and discover which district they live in. This tool can be found on the City's website at www.cityofconcord.org/elections.

Postcards with information about the City's transition to district elections will be mailed to all Concord residents the week of Oct. 15.

It's not too late to register to vote. The deadline to register is Oct. 22, and registration can be done online through www.registertovote.ca.gov or at any DMV office.
