

Special Event Policy by Tier

WIDESPREAD

Many non-essential indoor business operations are closed

The City of Concord is not accepting any event applications until the Contra Costa County Health order authorizes large public gatherings. Once the County approves public special events, the City will begin accepting applications slated for 60 days following the restrictions being lifted, to allow adequate time for City staff to review applications and permit events.

SUBSTANTIAL

Some non-essential indoor business operations are closed

The City of Concord is not accepting any event applications until the Contra Costa County Health order authorizes large public gatherings. Once the County approves public special events, the City will begin accepting applications slated for 60 days following the restrictions being lifted, to allow adequate time for City staff to review applications and permit events.

MODERATE

Some indoor business operations are open with modifications

The City of Concord is now accepting event applications for groups of 50 people or less, the plan for these smaller events must also be approved by the Contra Costa County Health Officer per the Health Order and meet the guidelines of the new event permit application.

The City will also begin accepting applications for larger events for 2021, these will not be approved, and no money will be accepted. These applications will be used to place a hold on park space so that groups will have consideration in 2021.

MINIMAL

Most indoor business operations are open with modifications

To be determined; based on official health order. We can assume small event approvals and continuing to accept applications for larger events- approval will be based on capacity restrictions set by Contra Costa County Health.
